What is involved:

Supplies and funds will be gathered, sorted, and packed at Christ Church, and delivered to the NuDay Syria warehouse in Nashua. Volunteers will help pack shipping containers.

Supplies being requested include:

- Rice, beans, powdered and liquid infant formula, powdered milk, tuna, protein bars, flour, sugar, cooking oil
- New to like-new clothes, bedding (blankets, sheets, sleeping bags), shoes
- Soccer balls, stuffed animals, crayons, non-battery operated toys
- Diapers, female pads, soap bars, powdered detergent, toothbrushes, toothpaste, pain relievers, vitamins

Packing materials:

- Heavy duty packaging tape (Scotch Brand)
- Thick black permanent markers Sharpies
- Small and Medium sized Home Depot Boxes
- Force Flex Glad Kitchen Trash bags (white)

**** Brand names are important because we've found that the many brands do not hold up to the long journey. Home Depot boxes are stronger than similar brands and Glad Force Flex Kitchen Trash bags are the only ones that don't tear easily. Cheap packaging tapes often come unstuck causing boxes to fall apart.*
