<sup>5</sup>So don't be afraid. I am with you.

I will gather you from the west.

<sup>6</sup>I will tell the north: Give my people to me.

I will tell the south: Don't keep my people in prison.

Bring my sons from far away.

Bring my daughters from faraway places.

<sup>7</sup>Bring to me all the people who are mine.

I made them for my glory.

I formed them; I made them."
